## FINE ARTS

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### ARCHITECTURE

Students will explore through hands-on projects the design of buildings, furniture and green buildings. The class will use recycled materials to build new buildings and structures found in cities and communities. Students will also take walking trips around the neighborhood to see the amazing architecture of NYC!

### ADVANCED WHEELTHROWING

A class for students who want to advance their wheelthrowing technique and craftsmanship. While improving their skills, students will be encouraged to explore their own style. Students must have taken Pottery 3. Permission of instructor required. *(Limit 6 students)*
