## KID'S CLUB

### KID'S CLUB, AGES 5-7

## FINE ARTS

---

### ARCHITECTURE 1

In this class we will explore how and why structures stand up through hands-on activities and projects, including model building. We will also take neighborhood walks to learn first-hand about the incredible architecture that surrounds us in New York City. **Tuesdays, ages 7 and 8 \$315.00**

### ARCHITECTURE 2

Students continue to review and elaborate on the ideas and projects covered in Architecture 1. We will explore through hands-on projects the design of buildings, furniture and green buildings. We will use recycled materials to build new buildings and structures found in cities and communities. **Fridays, ages 8 and up \$315.00**

### CARTOON ART

Children learn the basics of cartooning and anime-style drawing through guided lessons and free drawing. We will also learn figure drawing, character development and storyline. **M, Tu, ages 8 and up W, ages 5-7, F, ages 7 and up \$315.00, choose one day!**

### ENTER STAGE WRITE

A performance workshop in dramatic writing and theatre. Through theatrical improvisation children invent characters and create roles to play. Children write their own script for two performances per semester. **Tuesdays, ages 7 and up \$315.00**

### JEWELRY MAKING

Create jewelry, hair accessories, and even photo frames with beads, lanyard, and other unusual materials. Explore the way jewelry is made in many cultures. **Thursdays, 8 and up \$315.00**

### MIXED MEDIA ART

Learn to experiment with all kinds of materials and media in this innovative arts and crafts class. Students will work on group projects in bookmaking, sculpture, printmaking, and much more, *and* spend time each class working on individual student-designed projects. **Wednesdays, ages 6 and up \$315.00**

### PAINTING & DRAWING

This class is for students with a sincere interest in learning the fundamentals of painting and drawing. Using traditional fine art materials and building on basic techniques, we will explore how the two mediums relate in this supportive environment. All levels welcome.

### PHOTOGRAPHY 1

In this workshop students will be introduced to both the science and the art of photography. They will become familiar with its basic concepts in a fun and engaging way. ### POTTERY 1

Explore your creativity through clay in this beginning class. Students will learn basic hand-building and sculptural techniques and learn to paint their own pottery. *\$20.00 materials fee.* **Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays, ages 5-7, choose one day! \$315.00**

### POTTERY 2

This class is appropriate for both beginners and those with some clay experience. The basic techniques will be taught while children expand their creativity on projects and painting. *\$20.00 materials fee.* **Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays, ages 7-9, choose one day! \$315.00**

### POTTERY 3

For students with prior experience who are sincerely interested in refining their pottery skills. Independent projects will be encouraged and a basic introduction to the wheel will be taught. Must have Pottery 2 experience. *\$20.00 materials fee.* **Wednesdays or Fridays, ages 9 and up \$315.00**

### PRINTMAKING

This class will explore many different ways to make prints from potato prints to silk screens. Students will also learn to transform their ideas into sellable products like T-shirts, pillows and card designs. **Mondays, ages 8 and up \$315.00**

### PUPPETRY

From simple puppetry to advanced doll and puppet designs, this class encourages students of all ages and skill levels to create interesting characters with fabrics, felt, paper mache, and other materials. **Thursdays, ages 6 and up \$315.00**

### \*NEW\* SEQUENTIAL ART

This class will explore and experiment with combining images and narrative. Using original characters, we will discuss methods of written and visual storytelling to create comic strips and books. This is a great class for anyone who has taken Cartoon Art. **Wednesdays, ages 8 and up Thursdays, ages 5-7 \$315.00**

### SEWING & NEEDLECRAFTS

Students will learn to hand-sew and use a sewing machine to create amazing work in this fun class. We will also learn to bead and work on other kinds of needlecrafts. Students will create toys, clothes, quilts and more. **Wednesdays, ages 7 and up \$315.00**

### TAKING PICTURES

This class introduces young children to the magic of the light and photography. They will take pictures with a hand-made pinhole camera, as well as with a manual 35mm camera. In our darkroom they will develop and make their own prints. **Thursdays, ages 5-7 \$315.00**

### WOODWORKING

Children will create projects out of wood while exploring the medium in a way that allows for self-expression and development of imagination. Children are instructed in the techniques of the craft to ensure safety.
